This Boot Camp Training requires all participants to commit to the whole schedule as well as stay on site.

Part of the boot camp will include participants being divided up in squadrons (teams) to work together under authority with unity on assignments of servanthood and intercession. Discipline, timeliness, and following orders, are keys to well trained troops winning battles, taking territories, and maintaining beachheads.

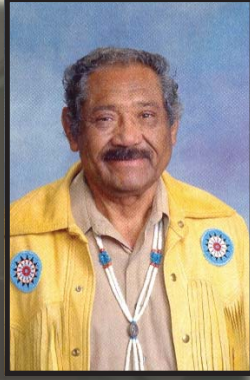

Boot Camp Leaders

Dr. Jay Swallow is a Native American Leader who is recognized for his apostolic leadership to the Church in America as well as internationally. He has a proven record in dealing with territorial strongholds.



Jay was born in 1939 on the Cheyenne Arapaho Reservation in NW Oklahoma. For over 40 years Dr. Swallow has preached, taught, and prayed for the Native people from the Arctic circle to Central America.

He was an apostolic father to many ministers years before he was asked to be a member of C. Peter Wagner's International Coalition of Apostles.

Dr. Swallow will teach on identifying the Strongman of territorial strongholds, identificational repentance, and high-level spiritual warfare. He currently gives apostolic leadership to the Oklahoma Concert of Prayer as well as traveling internationally dealing with Spiritual Warfare on both territorial and national levels.

Dr. Negiel Bigpond is a 4th generation minister of the Gospel, born in 1949. He has been an evangelist and pastor, evangelizing over 143 Native reservations and currently serves as Pastor of the Morning Star Evangelistic Center near Hectorville, Oklahoma.



Negiel is an accomplished musician and heads up the Two Rivers Native American Training Center south of Tulsa, where the two-week SWAT boot camps are held. He has established prayer teams who are skilled in spiritual warfare and intercession for the Native people and the issues that concern them.

Negiel's teaching will highlight understanding authority, honor, worship, and removing curses of the land. He is also a part of the International Coalition of Apostles. Currently he, too, gives apostolic leadership to the Oklahoma Concert of Prayer, as well as traveling internationally dealing with Spiritual Warfare on both territorial and national levels.

Dr. Jerry Mash founded and leads Mission Native America, whose mission is to see economic and spiritual freedom come to the host people of our land. He is also a part of the International Coalition of Apostles.

Dr. Mash is the founder and Pastor of the Church at the Northgate in Edmond, and helps lead the Oklahoma Apostolic Prayer Network (OAPN), a statewide organized prayer movement to see all of Oklahoma and the Home of the Red Man saved and transformed.

Dr. Mash has been successfully involved in the political and governmental arena as a strategist, advisor, and official. Jerry is also a Corporate and Securities lawyer that served as Administrative Assistant and Legal Staff Officer to the Governor of Oklahoma when the political structure of the State changed to two political parties. He was listed for years in Marqui's Who's Who in American Law.
