

## How Kingdom People View the Resurrection

Easter Sunday April 5, 2026

### What is a Kingdom Person?

- **Matthew 6:33** - *“Seek first the Kingdom of God.....”*
- We’re all (*those born again*) in the Kingdom; not all ‘of’ the Kingdom
- Someone becoming increasingly curious and familiar with the Kingdom and how it operates
- What it is; how it works; how to engage, interact, participate, communicate it to others
- Growing spiritually; becoming mature (*committed to the process*)
- Father/Kingdom - - Kingdom/Father
- Engaged in relationship with the Father - Interacts with - Their ‘*lifeline*’!
- Has their heart ‘*exposed*’ to the Father
- Are gravitating into their ‘*true identity*’, and growing in their son-ship through relationship and interaction with the Father
- Listening to the Father *\* (“Man shall not live by bread alone...”)*
- Living out what they’re hearing
- Are learning what it means to be led by the Spirit - Walking by faith
- Believes in the unseen more than what is visible
- Is excited about the time they’re living in
- Sees the Church, not as an organization but an organism purposed and destined by God to partner with Him to change the world for the better
- Awareness of what God is doing (*through fellowship with Him*)
- Serious about making the best of the time we’re given (*redeeming*)
- Understands the seriousness, the gravity, the critical nature of the times
- Understands they’re part of a much larger plan *\* (much bigger than us)*
- Is coming to the realization that life actually is the Great Adventure
  - Watching
  - Anticipating
  - Strategizing
- In the process of finding their place (*gifting and anointing*)
- Understands their importance to the whole Body
- Coming into the awareness of their value to the Father and His plan
- Aware of their importance and significance to the plan of God

- Are learning what it means to be about the Father's business; and actively engaged in the process
- Has taken up their cross
- Is a Giver - Not a taker! *\*(not talking about finances...)*
- Kingdom people have a different perspective *\*(about everything!)*
- Kingdom people stay in the mode of change (evolving)
- Kingdom people are in the lifelong process of learning to love like Jesus
- Be a Kingdom person!

### **But, how do they view the resurrection?**

- The ultimate display of love the world has ever/will ever see
- The bedrock event of the entire Christian faith

- Inspires us to be all He created us to be
