

Signs and Wonders #9

AT's Snacks-- September 7, 2025

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Monday:

As you grow in your understanding of the kingdom, life has unlimited experience of both good and bad, mountains and valleys, and an understanding of the kingdom helps you put those things in perspective. For whatever it is you're dealing with, good or bad, mountains or valleys, you have adequate grace to carry you through that.

When you start to believe the stuff we are talking about around here, but don't walk it out, nothing really happens. But when you start to walk that out, you have become a problem to the forces of darkness.

If you are under attack, congratulations, because now you're someone that the enemy has to deal with. You've been given authority over all the power of the enemy, but if you don't use the authority, you can still get beat up by the enemy.

These are the things the enemy uses against you: success, lies, deception, confusion, accusation, condemnation, temptation, compromise, doubt, fear, anger, bitterness, relational conflict, division, distraction, discouragement, offense (someone offends you), unforgiveness, lust, envy, greed, pride, oppression and intimidation. Some others are: weariness, religion, busy-ness (too busy), rebellion, jealousy, strife, idolatry, worry and regret.

A lot of people live in the past, over past stuff they did in their life. You've been forgiven of all that stuff. But here's what we need to do; move on and not let those things direct you the rest of your life.

This generation is going to see the greatest move of God that the planet has ever seen. It's happening right now. Nobody I know, no group anywhere, should be more prepared for this than you. **I'm talking seriously to you.**

Tuesday:

Here are the some of the reasons that we aren't seeing more signs and wonders:

- Unbelief
- Misunderstood Identity.... You'll never know how important you are to Him and how important you are to His plan, until you give yourself in that relationship and keep doing that.
- Ignorance.... A lack of knowledge
- Religious Orientation.... Not believing in signs and wonders in this present day.
- Lack of exercising Faith.... You may not be using enough of it, but you have enough of it.
- Failure to submit to authority.... Insensitive to the Holy Spirit.... Quenching or grieving the Spirit.... Personal agenda.... Low self image.... Feeling unqualified.... Spiritual laziness.... Inconvenience (you don't want your life to be interrupted) Agenda-based.... Habitual sin (calling yourself a kingdom person, but you keep doing non kingdom things) Pride.... Self-centeredness.... Uncomfortable surroundings.... Fear of being labeled a religious fanatic.... Demonic interference

Joel 2:28-29 says, *"And it shall come to pass afterward that I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh. Your sons and daughters shall prophecy. Your old men shall dream dreams. Your young men shall see visions. And on my menservants, and my maidservants, I will pour out My Spirit in those days".*

To dream is a gift that God has given you and the enemy wants to counterfeit that. He wants to skew that, and he wants to get in the way of you dreaming anything that has any kind of spiritual significance.

Please read John 4:12-18. Part of it says this, “**He dwells with you and will be in you**”. He’s literally in you. You’re in Him. You’re in Christ. Christ is in you by virtue of the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit, the most incredible, magnificent gift that’s ever been given in the context of time and eternity.

God comes to us in the form of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit of God is all God. God the Father and Jesus the Son and the Holy Spirit, three in one. They’re a triune being.

The first step in operating in signs and wonders is learning to be sensitive to the Spirit. You have an unfair advantage over the world, over the demonic realm, because the Spirit of God lives in you. “*God in you, the hope of glory*”.

Wednesday:

1 Corinthians 2:16 say, “*For who has known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ*”. Philippians 2:5 says, “*Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus*”.

You have the mind of Christ, but now you have to let the wisdom and revelation of the spirit and from the spirit to have precedence over your own knowledge, your own understanding in your own experience. All of it comes down to learning to be sensitive to the Holy Spirit, Who lives in you. It’s not hard, but it takes some effort on your part.

Acts 13:2 says, “*As they ministered to the Lord*”. I’m not talking about having a song service that’s not from the heart. I’m talking about a real deep spiritual thing happening in the heart. **Worship is how you minister to the Lord. In true worship, the Holy Spirit talks, reveals and shows us stuff.**

THE GIFT is the Holy Spirit and there are nine manifestations of that gift. There’s so much misunderstanding and so much dumb, stupid teaching out there on this stuff, and it causes people to either shy away from it, not wanting to mess with it, or they get over in the ditch in one or two of these manifestations and it really doesn’t work that well at all.

If the Holy Spirit is in you and dwells in you, the potential for all those nine manifestations are right there, resident in you, right this minute. They’ve been given to you. You didn’t earn them. They’re gifts, but all these are based on your willingness to cooperate with Him in that, and in your availability.

These nine manifestations are: The word of knowledge, word of wisdom, faith, healing, miracles, prophecy, discerning of spirits, tongues and interpretation of tongues.

It’s a supernatural empowering to be baptized in the Holy Spirit. You have to get this part for the work of the ministry. Acts 1:8 says, “*You shall receive power after the Holy Spirit comes upon you*”.

Let’s make it a priority to learn to be more sensitive to His Spirit, so pay attention, even in the business of your day, because He has His ways to get your attention.

Thursday:

The Holy Spirit:

- Is a Teacher.... When you read in the word and something just kind of lights up, or you get a revelation, or it illuminates something or becomes clear to you that you've read maybe before, maybe never read before. That's the Spirit of God teaching you when you read the Bible. That's why you need to be people of the word.
- It's the Spirit of God that gives you understanding about the things that are contained in the word, to make it clear to you and reminds us of what we need to know.
- He convicts us of sin, righteousness and judgment.... The Spirit teaches us right from wrong. He has a gentle, tender way to show you where you were in error, maybe on something that you should have said or should not have said. He does that with me all the time. So learn to start paying attention to that.

You have the mind of Christ, but you have to let the mind of Christ in. There are people who are serious and worry about the judgment day of Christ. I'm not worried about it. Mike Dyer taught us this; a believer's sins have preceded him to the judgment seat of Christ, where you've already been judged, innocent, not guilty.

Whom the Son sets free is free indeed, so you need to start living in the freedom that's already been purchased for you. You're going to mess up. You're going to do something you should haven't have done, so back up, correct it and move on.

I'm trying to be nice and gentle, but we also don't have any tolerance around here for people to say, *"Well, you know. I'm just a sinner"*. You're not. You've been born again. When you said yes to Jesus, the seed of perfection was germinated down in your spirit, where it was intended to be. Germinated by your own act, your own will of believing in what you've already been given.

You want to talk about seeing more signs and wonders? Some of it comes down to your willingness to allow the work- the steady, constant work of the Holy Spirit in you, to bring you to truth, to bring you to righteousness, to conform you into the image of Jesus.

You look at Jesus and you look at yourselves, and you think, *"I have a long way to go"*. But you know what? He's patient and long suffering, which means He puts up with a lot. It's because it's all about the intent of your heart. In Proverbs, it say to guard your heart, for out of it flow the issues of life. It's your spirit, the real you, the real part of you, and it is going to be alive a million, gazillion years from now.

Friday:

Righteousness doesn't happen from some guy up here beating on you because of your sin. Righteousness only comes from you connecting with the Father and seeing how important you are to Him, and then you want to change because you see how you are, then you see how God sees you.

The Holy Spirit reveals the Father to us. If you are paying attention to Him, and you're taking time to listen and bask in the presence of God, you begin to feel like the son or daughter that God Himself has placed in you, and how important you are to Him.

I'm His favorite, and if you don't think you're His favorite, you must not have spent much time with Him lately, because that's how He makes you feel.

The Holy Spirit directs you on how you should pray, if you want to pray strategically. Sometimes we don't know how we ought to pray, but the Spirit of God helps us in our weakness with groanings, which can not be uttered.

- He shows us things to come, in the future. Doors that need to be opened, thing to avoid, things to pay attention to.
- He guides us into all truth. If you're not anchored in the Lord, it's hard to figure out what's true and what's not true. Even if you are anchored in the Lord, it's hard to get truth out there. It's hard to find out what's really true.
- He produces the fruit of the Spirit in us: love, joy, peace, patience, long suffering, kindness, gentleness, and self control.
- He gives us assurance of salvation. It just bothers me for people to say, "*You know, I hope I'm good with God*". You are good with God. He's good with you. Now, maybe you need to make some changes in your life, but God's good with you, and that's where grace comes in.

95% of the Bible Belt world thinks God is mad at them, and they're not doing enough. Please get off of that. That's the dumbest stuff I've ever heard. And if you know God, if you understand anything about grace, it seems dumb to you too.

The enemy would love to convince you all the time that you're not saved. You're not good enough. That's what he does. It's one of those devices he's using, always trying to confuse you, and deceive you. So get off of that.

Saturday:

The Holy Spirit gives us assurance of salvation and strengthens our inner man. He brings freedom to the spirit part of us. You have freedom, but you have to walk in it. You have to walk in truth. You have to walk by faith. It's impossible to please God without faith.

- He pours God's love into our heart, and He gives us boldness to speak God's word. Boldness is being willing and available to do whatever God wants you to do, at whatever time God wants you to do it.
- He illuminates scripture and He makes the Bible come alive.
- He's our comforter. He comforts you anytime you need it.
- He seals us as God's own.
- He produces unity in the Body of Christ.
- He transforms us into the image of Jesus.
- He testifies with our spirit that we are children of God.
- He brings the peace and joy of God. You can't have the peace of God if you don't embrace God in relationship.
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The Holy Spirit refreshes and renews us. "*For the Lord has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power, love and a sound mind*". A mind that thinks and reasons well.

Jesus came to the earth in the flesh, and left His deity and His supernatural abilities behind. He gave us the example of how you get desperate, utterly dependent and helpless without God. That was Him as the Son of Man, allowing God to do in Him, for Jesus to show you and me the same things that God wants to do through us. This is simple. It's just that not very many people do it.

To heal the broken hearted, you have an anointing to proclaim liberty to the captives, in their mindsets, from demonic influence and of low image of themselves. He's freed you up from that so you can be just like Jesus. This is where it goes to the next level. This is where stuff really happens, where you start to set people free.
