

Signs and Wonders #2

AT's Snacks-- July 20, 2025

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Monday:

If you are not engaging and interacting in a relational way with the Father, the Creator of the universe, where you and Him are intimate with one another, you missed the whole 14 weeks that we talked about it. So take that time with the Father.

In Genesis 1, everything that God did and everything He does with you is supernatural. God spoke it all into being and made something from nothing. He can do that in your life, and He wants to do it and show you how to operate in that too, so you can encourage other people.

We're created in the image of God, which says to me that we're hardwired for the miraculous. It's in your makeup before you were even born again. It was built into you. That's part of the image.

I've been in a place or two lately where I just had to keep my mouth shut, because I know that if I talked, what would come out wasn't going to be very good. So it's so important that we watch our words.

Make sure that your confession lines up with what you just prayed for. Psalms 19:14 says, *"Let the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O Lord"*.

Psalms 141:3 says, *"Set a guard, Oh Lord over my mouth, keep watch over the door of my lips"*.

Please take the time to read Mark 16:14-18. This scripture sets the tone for the rest of this teaching.

Signs and wonders are supernatural demonstrations of God's presence, power and purpose designed to confirm and validate His word and invite people of every generation into an authentic loving relationship with the Father, whereby we fulfill His incredible plan for our life.

In Mark 16:17, Jesus appeared to the 11 and rebuked their unbelief and their hardness of heart because they didn't believe those who had seen Him after He had risen. He expected them by now to kind of be like what I kind of expect of you.

By now, we should expect of one another that we're growing up in this stuff, that we're not continuing to be babies in the Lord.

When the disciples woke Jesus up during the storm, He said, *"Peace. Be still"*. They didn't pray about it, He just spoke it into being. That's one of the things that we're going to learn to do. There's times where we need to pray and really contend, but there are other times where you just declare it, like Jesus did.

Jesus was saying, *"When are you guys going to pick up the torch and do this stuff yourself"*. That's what we should be saying to one another.

What God wants to do all over, not just here, is to create an atmosphere where the supernatural becomes commonplace.

"Whatever you bind on earth will be bound in the heavenlies, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in the heavenlies". Jesus has delegated spiritual authority, legitimate, legal, spiritual authority to you. You have that kind of authority. You can either use it or not use it. **God is testing us in the natural to see if He can trust us with the supernatural.**

Everybody knows that we should become as a child, but nobody ever tells you what it takes to become as a child. Let's mature into child likeness.

Testings are a key to what the Father is trying to teach you. *"Count it all joy when you fall into various trials, knowing that testing of your faith produces patience, but let patience have its perfect work"*. The only places where you really need to be tested is the places that are not like Jesus yet.

Romans 8:29 says, "For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren". That makes Jesus our older brother. He left His deity and His supernatural power behind for us, to use to carry on the business of the Father.

How do you make the transfer of what Jesus did to you? It's your time with the Father. Those are times when you listen, when God whispers things to your spirit that you know what to do.

What Jesus did was He saw what the Father was doing and he did what the Father did. How does that work? Spend your time listening to the Father. You'll know what to do.

I'm not teaching about giving, but if you want to make it about giving, when you give, you unlock the supernatural. That's a sign and a wonder. That's something that God did based on what you did anyway.

The greatest supernatural sign, is salvation, and the transformation that ensues, the transformation that happens if you cooperate with Him.

You have strong, strong faith. You're the one that activates your faith. No one can activate your faith besides you. You build your faith through the small things, just the things that you deal with on an everyday basis.

Signs, wonders and miracles point to the Father. God uses these to bless, encourage, energize, support, and sustain us as we go along.

A sign is a miracle regarded as evidence of supernatural power. Rainbows are great signs. For me, it doves. For Elijah, it was the cloud the size of a man's hand.

Wonders are things that bring awe, like amazement or an event that draws attention to God. His existence is authenticity. God does that to prove that He exists. Sometimes you get so used to hearing stuff, you just become numb to it.

When I have people come down and pray for someone, it's a family anointing, which means you have to goods to bless. You're armed and dangerous to the forces of darkness. You need to pick up on that.

The definition of miracles is a surprising and welcome event that is not explicable or explainable by natural or scientific laws. Miracles demonstrate the power of God. Some of those were walking on water and raising people from the dead.

If you are in a situation that looks impossible, it's not impossible. *"With God, nothing is impossible"*. If so, you're eligible for a miracle when all of your other options have dried up.

All these things reveal the Father, which proves His existence, reveals His love, draws us closer to Him and ignites the fire in us to operate in the supernatural ourselves. It's to encourage believers and to convince unbelievers.

Look closely. Monitor your prayer life. Are you praying for open doors? Are you praying that God would use you in this way? Because He's really attracted to those who ask those kinds of things that He's already given. You already have those things. It's a matter of you learning how to walk in those

things.

Are you contending for signs and wonders? *“You have not because you ask not, or when you ask with selfish motives”*. It’s the intent of our heart that makes all the difference.

Proverbs 4:23 says, “Guard your heart with all diligence, for out of it spring the issues of life”. Everything that you encounter in life flows out from your heart, the spirit part of you which is the control room for your life. So guard it! Pay attention to the attitude, the intent of your own heart. The Holy Spirit will help you do that.

We as kingdom people are to make right everything in the world that we encounter that’s not like Jesus or not like His Kingdom. How do we pray? “Our Father, which art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. **Your kingdom come**”. He’s asking us to pray that, but He’s also inviting us to participate with Him and to partner with Him to do that.

It’s in our hands. It’s in the hands of the church. He’ll give you all that, but you have use your faith to activate the supernatural realm.

Start to look for the Lord in the really simple, mundane things of life, because He’s there and He does stuff. If you’re paying attention, you’ll see them, and when you see them, honor God. I’m giving honor to God in every one of those things that I see. HONOR HIM!

Get out of your own way. Cooperate. Be consistent. Don’t try it one time and stop because you didn’t think it will work. Be consistent in your walk with Him and in what we’re talking about.

Lord, I believe, but help me with my unbelief. That’s a good prayer for anybody.
