

Signs and Wonders #1

AT's Snacks-- July 13, 2025

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Monday:

"Seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these other things will be added to you". If you want to get your life in proper order, the first step, the first plan of action, is to get your focus on the kingdom. Make yourself a student of the Kingdom of God.

To have a relationship with the Father is not just conceptual, but experiential, where you and He are experiencing life together. That's the key.

We talk about church government, and I want you young lions to pay attention. We didn't get here by doing it some other way. We got here by doing it the way the Bible says to do it and how the church is supposed to be built, upon the foundation of apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers.

The gifts and calling of God are irrevocable, which means the if you're called and you didn't do it, the call is still on your life.

For the kingdom person, everything you do is ministry. Ministry is an outflow of what's happening in your heart only as a direct result of your relationship and your interaction with the Father. That is your field of ministry to the people that you're around- first your family, and then your circle of influence.

Every one of us needs someone in our life who will tell us the things that we don't want to hear, but that we really, really need to hear. You can be that for someone else, but don't forget, you need that person in your life as well. Someone who can tell you what you don't want to hear, even when you don't want to hear it.

The bottom line is that you have to cross the threshold of fear of ministering to someone. And remember, when someone comes to you, telling you their problems, number one is they trust you and two, they are asking for help. This is one of the easiest ways to start ministering.

Tuesday:

The Kingdom of God that we talk about around here is a supernatural kingdom and it's right now, it's here and it's perfect, but it doesn't manifest in the natural realm until you step out and do something like giving someone a call and maybe praying with them.

"These signs will follow those who believe in My name. They will cast out demons. They will speak with new tongues. They will take up serpents, and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them. They will lay hands on the sick and they will recover". God is saying, *"I've got you, no matter what happens".*

If we are paying attention, God gives us little signs all along the way. For me, it's doves that I see. It's God's way of saying to me, *"It's alright. I got this and I got you".*

If I would ask you if you believe, most of you are going to say, "Yes". But the acid test is not whether you say you believe, but the acid test is: *"these signs that follow them who believe"*. That's where the rubber hits the road.

Your words are so important. There are many who say that God doesn't do miracles anymore, and

people who say that, it's a self fulfilling prophecy. If you say that, you'll walk that out in your life.

Those of you who are becoming mature in the Lord, mothers and fathers in the Lord to others, start taking someone with you when you go to do ministry, and let them watch and observe how you do it.

Jesus, after His resurrection, rebuked His disciples because of their unbelief and their hardness of heart, because they didn't believe those who had seen Him after He had risen.

Wednesday:

Every generation hands the baton off to the next generation. And it's my opinion, based on everything that I read in the Bible, that the manifestation and the display of signs and wonders should have never waned. In my opinion, it should be escalating all the time.

"Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature". The good news of this gospel that He's talking about is the gospel of the kingdom. It's the good news of the Kingdom of God.

I want to get you to start paying attention to the words that you speak.

This generation is about to see the greatest display of signs and wonders that the world has ever seen. You mark my word. Write it down. It's happening right now, if you're paying attention to kingdom things. So don't mess around too long, sitting on the bench. It's time for you to listen.

The supernatural signs and wonders and miracles are woven into the fabric of the creation story from the very beginning, and they were intended to be a part of a kingdom believer's life forever.

If God is supernatural and God spoke the world into being, and you are birthed and created after God, wouldn't it be smart to assume that you have the same qualities that God has now? I'm not making you equal with God, but the Bible says that we're being conformed into the image of Jesus. Well, that's a monumental task, even for the Holy Spirit.

Thursday:

Everything about the Kingdom of God is supernatural. All those things He did there in Genesis, one, are all supernatural acts. We're created in His image. We're created to be like Him. Jesus was the firstborn of many brethren, and we have the same Father as He has.

By that, Jesus has given us permission to relate to the Creator of the universe, God, exactly like Jesus does, as Father. I think we should take Him up on that.

You are created in Christ Jesus for good works. And the works are prepared beforehand that you should walk in them. So, He is waiting for someone like you, someone who, by faith, will step into an impossible-looking situation, and just declare and speak what God's speaking to your heart and see things change in a miraculous way.

Signs, wonders and miracles are good evidence that the kingdom is working like it's supposed to work. He did all this by His words, which are a key for us, your voice, your words, and your declarations. Everything that you say matters.

A year ago, God told me two things in 2025 to watch out for. First, a year of transition, but I had no idea that it was going to be as much transformative as it is. The second is that we have to watch our words and pay attention to our words. You have to have your confession lined up with what you pray.

When you ask something and you don't ask it in faith, you're like a wave of the sea, driven back and forth, tossing and turning all the time. **So your faith has to be activated. You can activate your faith by your words.**

For assuredly, I say to you, whosoever says to the mountain, "be removed and cast into the sea".... He's not talking about literal mountains here. What He's talking about is these obstacles that get in our way in life. The things that we think there's no way through, or no way around.

Friday:

You need to start talking differently. You need to start declaring differently. Don't be tossed to and fro by every wind of doctrine. You should be steady as she goes. That's one of those things where the works are prepared beforehand, that you should walk in them.

Everything you do is ministry. I'm talking about an opportunity for you to speak life into a dead, discouraged situation for someone. That's ministry. It's an outflow, which happens as a result of your relationship with the Father.

He said, "Lord, I believe. I believe, but help my unbelief". That's kind of my prayer too. Like the Lord said to me about 2 years ago, *"Expect to be inundated with impossible-looking situations. With man, there are things that are impossible, but with God, nothing is impossible".*

Your words activate the spirit realm when you speak, as it's lined up with the word of God. When you speak that, you're creating an atmosphere for the manifestation of a miracle. So whether it looks like it or not, don't be discouraged by what you see, because remember, the stuff you see is what is temporary but the unseen things are eternal.

Some of you have prayed for years to be healed from something and it hasn't happened. I've got physical things I'm praying about. I'm not going to stop praying about them, but in the meantime, God's given me grace to walk it out with the things that I'm dealing with. So, the key is you're going to get enough grace whichever way you go.

Your words activate your faith. Your faith is extremely powerful, but you have to use it, and your words help, voicing out the things you think you're hearing from the Father.

If I think it's the Lord, I'm not going to leave it alone. If I think it's the Lord, I'm going to put some thought into that. I'm going to get quiet with no agenda before the Lord, and let the Lord speak to me and lead me into deeper truths.

Saturday:

You have to learn to not argue yourself out of a real word from God, just because it's so far-fetched. You have to watch yourself on that one, because logic will argue yourself out of a miracle if you're not careful.

When God speaks to you about something specific, say it out loud. When you say these things out loud and get them into the atmosphere, something happens. The Holy Spirit gives the things that are in your mind, your psyche, your makeup LIFE.

Please take the time to read James 3: 1-12. It is such an important scripture as it pertains to what we speak. Please take the time to read this.

If any man can control the tongue, he's getting somewhere, any person who learns to control their

tongue is growing in the Lord.

Watch your words. Pay attention to what you're saying. David was always making these declarations, "*Lord, set a guard over my mouth that doesn't say any unclean thing*" or something like that. So that's something that we need constant help from the Holy Spirit.

We are going to reap the good and the bad of the words we speak. "*For by your words, you'll be justified, and by your words, you will be condemned*".

What you say shapes reality. Your words are much more important and more powerful than you think. Your words are the connecting tissue by which all miracles are released into the natural realm.
